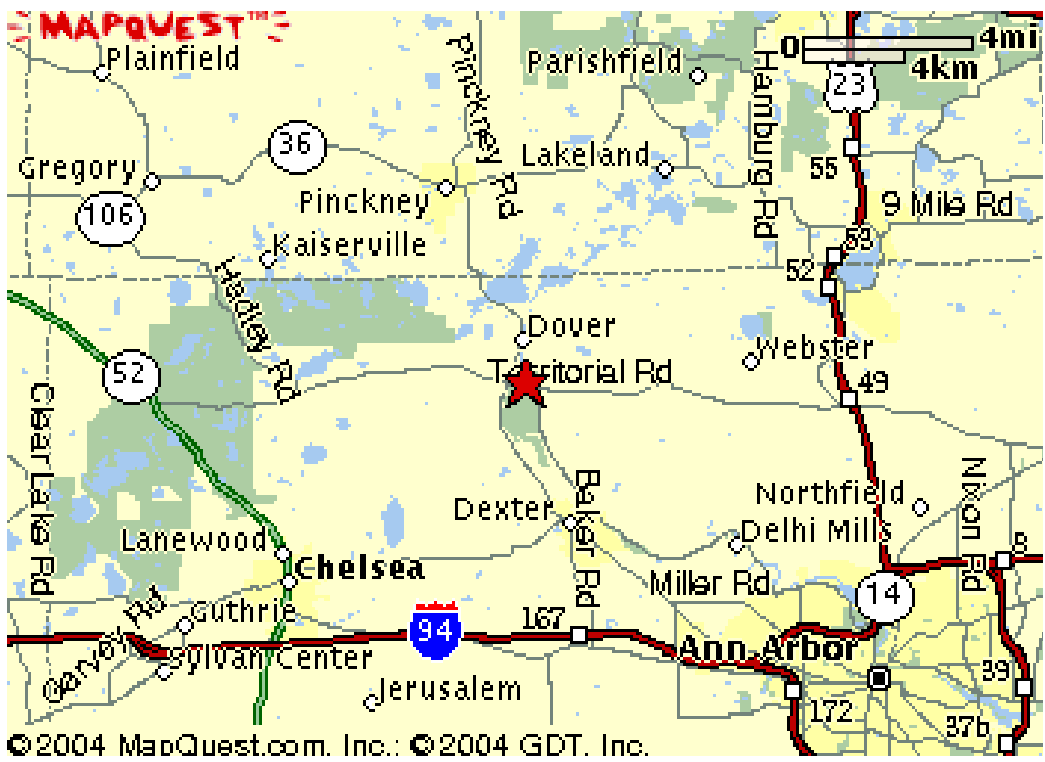
## **Second Annual Summer Picnic and August Meeting**

**Where: Hudson Mills Metropark, Picnic Shelter 4**

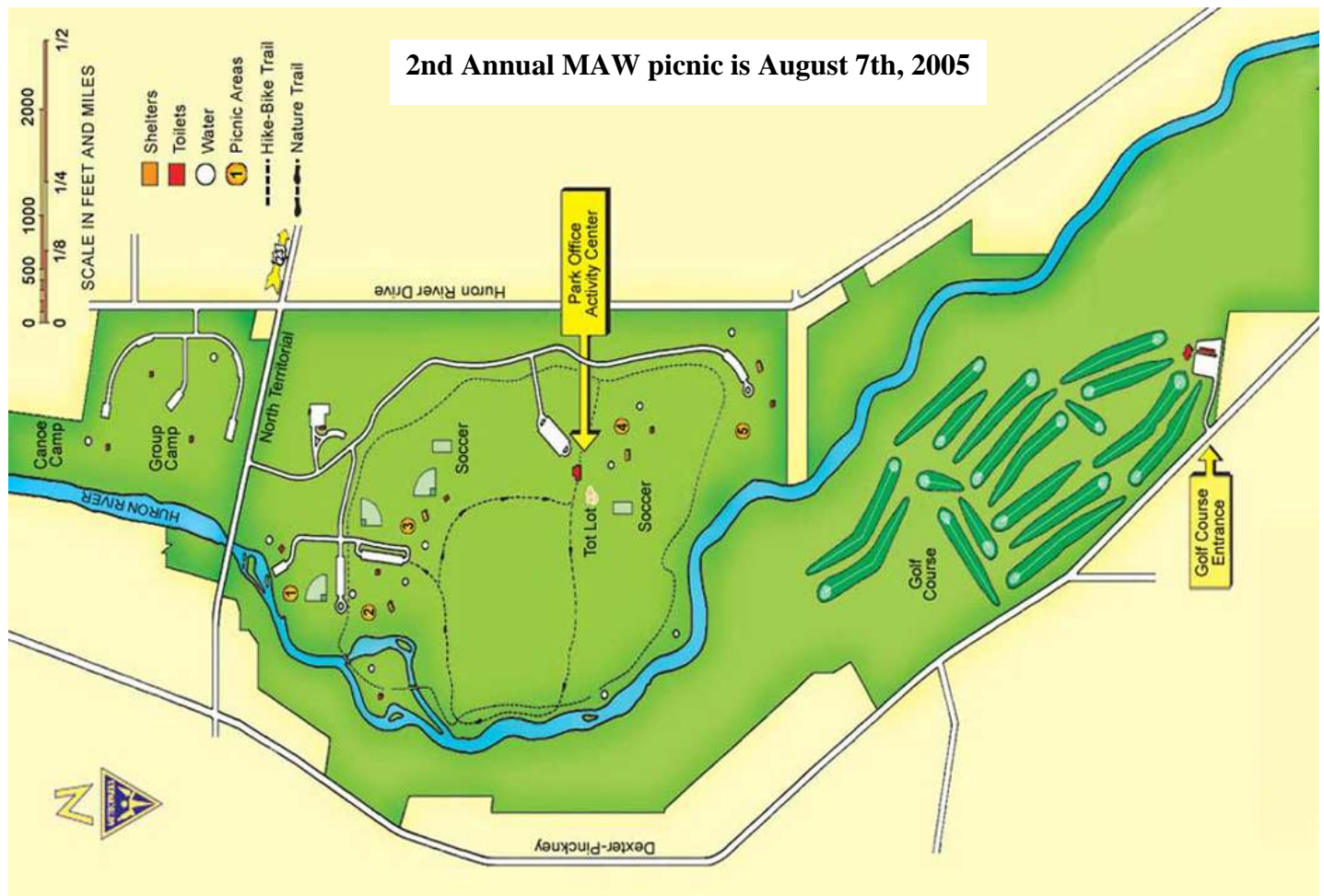
