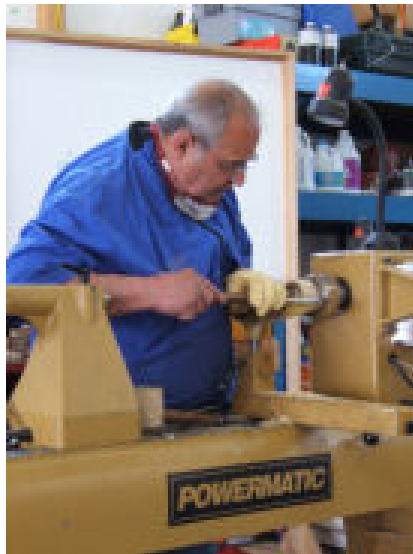

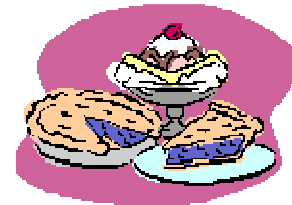

Rick Baird has joined the club at our last meeting. Please introduce yourself and make him feel welcome.

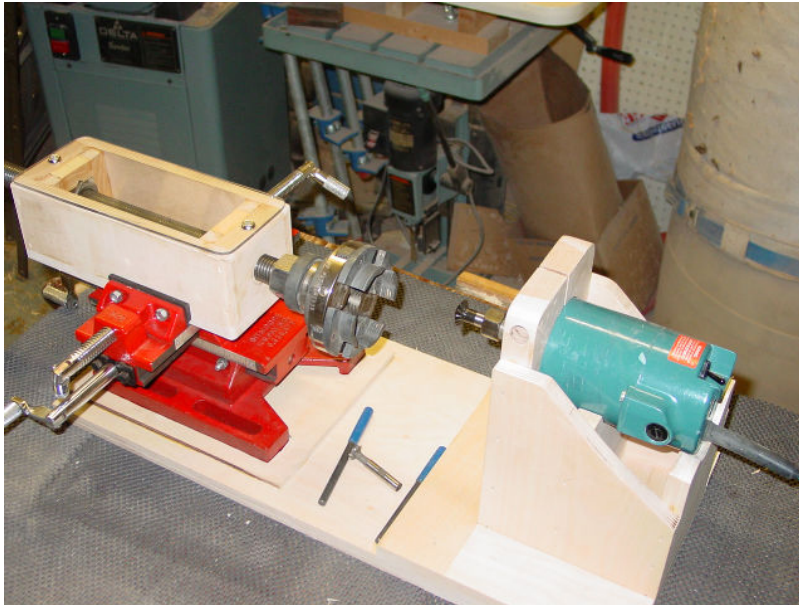

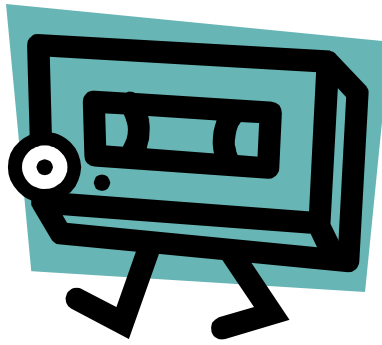
