Keith Fulmer Demonstration

At our December meeting Keith Fulmer paid us a visit. Keith demonstrated some of the burning and carving techniques that he uses on his pieces.

Keith demonstrated a number of techniques for texturing a project. In the piece shown below Keith turned the Big Leaf Maple Burl to the desired shape. Then using texturing tools such as



rotary burs, a wood burner, and sanding mandrel the surface was further refined.

Keith demonstrated how applying burned designs in different patterns with various tips can provide different effects. Then

by using the burn marks as a guide a rotary bur with a safe end can be used to quickly carve the wood to the desired shape. The safe side is used to follow the lines left by the wood burner.

This wall hanging was finished with lacquer after the burning and dyes were applied.

One thing to keep in mind when using burning to texture and highlight your piece is that sanding or cleaning with a small brush can remove some of the crispness and detail that the burning can provide.
